1. Before you can make a submission, you will need to click the “Doctoral Colloquium Paper Submission” link on the [conference website](#) to log in or set up an account with Oxford Abstracts.
2. Once registered, you can make your submission by completing the fields in the online submission form. Please note that mandatory fields are marked with an asterisk (\*).
